Morten Hviid was appointed to the Norwich Law School in September 2004 as a Professor in competition law. He has previously held posts in the Economics Departments at University of Copenhagen and University of Warwick and in the School of Economic and Social Studies, University of East Anglia. Within the Centre he primarily works on issues relating to cartels and the role of private enforcement in competition law.
